Middle School Dual Language Program Timeline	
November 1, 2016	Middle School Dual Language Enrollment packet made available online, at dual language elementary schools, and at dual language middle schools.
February 3, 2017	Parent Commitment Form must be submitted to your zoned dual language middle school listed above by the end of the business day. Note: All students coming from a previous AISD dual language program and are enrolling at their zoned dual language middle school are automatically accepted.
March 10, 2017	Transfer Students ONLY- Acceptance or Denial letters are mailed. See checklist below.

Middle School Dual Language Program Parent Commitment Form submitted to assigned middle school by February 3, 2017 . Students are automatically accepted at their zoned dual language middle school, if you desire your child to attend a different dual language middle school, acceptance will be determined based on available space.	
Along with submitting Parent Commitment Form, you must follow school registration process at assigned middle school.	
If your child's assigned middle school campus does not offer Dual Language and you require a DL campus NOT in your zone, submit Parent Commitment Form to desired middle school by February 3, 2017 and... <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Your child will be entered in an equal opportunity school lottery process if necessary. • Acceptance or denial letters will be mailed March 10, 2017. • If your child is denied admission to the program due to lack of available space, you will be given information as to his/her position on the wait list. • If accepted into the program, you should contact the middle school to register your child. • Your commitment to the Dual Language Program will override any other type of transfer, not including magnet programs.

Your child has participated in the AISD Dual Language Program in elementary school and now has the opportunity to participate in the district's Dual Language Enrichment Program at the secondary level.
